Welcome to Ms. McKenzie's School Counselor's Corner! I am the 4K-8th grade school counselor at HPEMS. I have the pleasure of working with students through the use of classroom guidance lessons, small group counseling, and individual counseling. In order to best meet the needs of the students at HPEMS, I work closely with school staff and parents.

The mission of the School Counseling Program at HPEMS is to address the academic, personal/social and career development of all students. As the school counselor I will strive to empower each student to reach their maximum potential academically and socially. I will work in partnership with parents, educators, and the community to ensure our students are prepared with the knowledge and skills needed to be productive and responsible citizens.

Classroom Guidance Lessons

I visit classrooms multiple times throughout the school year. I conduct 30-minute lessons that cover topics such as character traits, social skills, study skills, and problem-solving skills.

Small Group Counseling Sessions

I offer a variety of small group sessions to students who may benefit from some extra time developing social and emotional skills. Group sessions consist of 3-5 members that meet once a week during lunch.

Individual Counseling Sessions

Some students may benefit from one-on-one counseling on topics that include social and emotional challenges. Students may schedule appointments, or teachers may make referrals as needed.
